By car

Coming from the highway (A1): Take highway exit Salzburg Nord (A1), turn right towards Itzling/Maria Plain, continue onto Salzburger Straße, Bahnhofstraße, Kirchenstraße, Itzlinger Hauptstraße, Austraße, Rosa-Kerschbaumer-Straße and Jakob Haringer Straße. Follow the green information boards to the Techno-Z. Turn left onto Jakob-Haringer-Straße after the Hofer supermarket to the left. Pass the OMV gas station and continue to the “TECHNO 3” building. Parking spaces for visitors are located at the end of the street as well as in the Techno-Z underground car park.

Coming from the city center (Staatsbrücke): Continue from Schwarzstraße onto Haunspergstraße. After the company Hectas (to the right) take the second right (Sylvester-Oberberger-Straße), then turn left into Plainstraße. Follow Plainstraße past the rail tracks. After the tracks, follow Rosa-Kerschbaumer-Straße and turn right onto Jakob-Haringer-Straße at the Hofer supermarket. Pass the OMV gas station and continue to the “TECHNO 3” building. Parking spaces for visitors are located at the end of the street as well as in the Techno-Z underground car park.

By public transport

Take Bus No 6 towards Itzling from the city center (Theatergasse/Mirabellplatz) or main station and get off at Jakob-Haringer-Straße. Continue on foot past the OMV gas station to arrive at Techno-Z building “TECHNO 3”.

By train

From the main square in front of Salzburg main station take Bus No 6 towards Itzling and get off at Jakob-Haringer-Straße. Continue on foot past the OMV gas station to arrive at Techno-Z building “TECHNO 3”.

By plane

From Salzburg Airport W.A. Mozart take Bus No 2 and get off at Hauptbahnhof Salzburg (main station). Change to Bus No 6 towards Itzling and get off at Jakob-Haringer-Straße. Continue on foot past the OMV gas station to arrive at Techno-Z building “TECHNO 3”.
